WHEREAS, Deputy Steven Sinor was assigned to the Corrections Operations Bureau for two and a half years, after which he transferred to the Enforcement Operations Bureau for nineteen and a half years and while assigned to Enforcement, Deputy Sinor worked patrol duties in all three stations; and

WHEREAS, over his twenty-two, years of service **Deputy Steven Sinor** served for five Monterey County Sheriffs: Norman G Hicks, Gordon Sonne, Mike Kanalakis, Scott K. Miller, and Steve Bernal; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Steven Sinor performed admirably in his law enforcement career where he served as a Field Training Officer and in 2005 was a founding member of the Monterey County Sheriff's Office Bomb Team; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Steven Sinor received letters of appreciation from Sheriff Kanalakis as well as the Salinas Police Department and the Monterey Police Department; one letter of appreciation specifically focused on his exemplary work with the bomb squad; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Steven Sinor was nominated for Deputy of the Month in 2004 for his work on numerous burglaries and thefts in the Toro Park area and his investigation and subsequent arrest had a tremendous impact on the community he served; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Steven Sinor was selected as a Field Training Officer (FTO) in 2007 where he strived to train, educate and mentor new deputy sheriff's; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey on behalf of all residents thereof, acknowledges, commends and thanks **Deputy Steven Sinor** for his twenty-two years of exemplary public service to the residents of Monterey County, as a valued member of the Monterey County Sheriff's Office.
