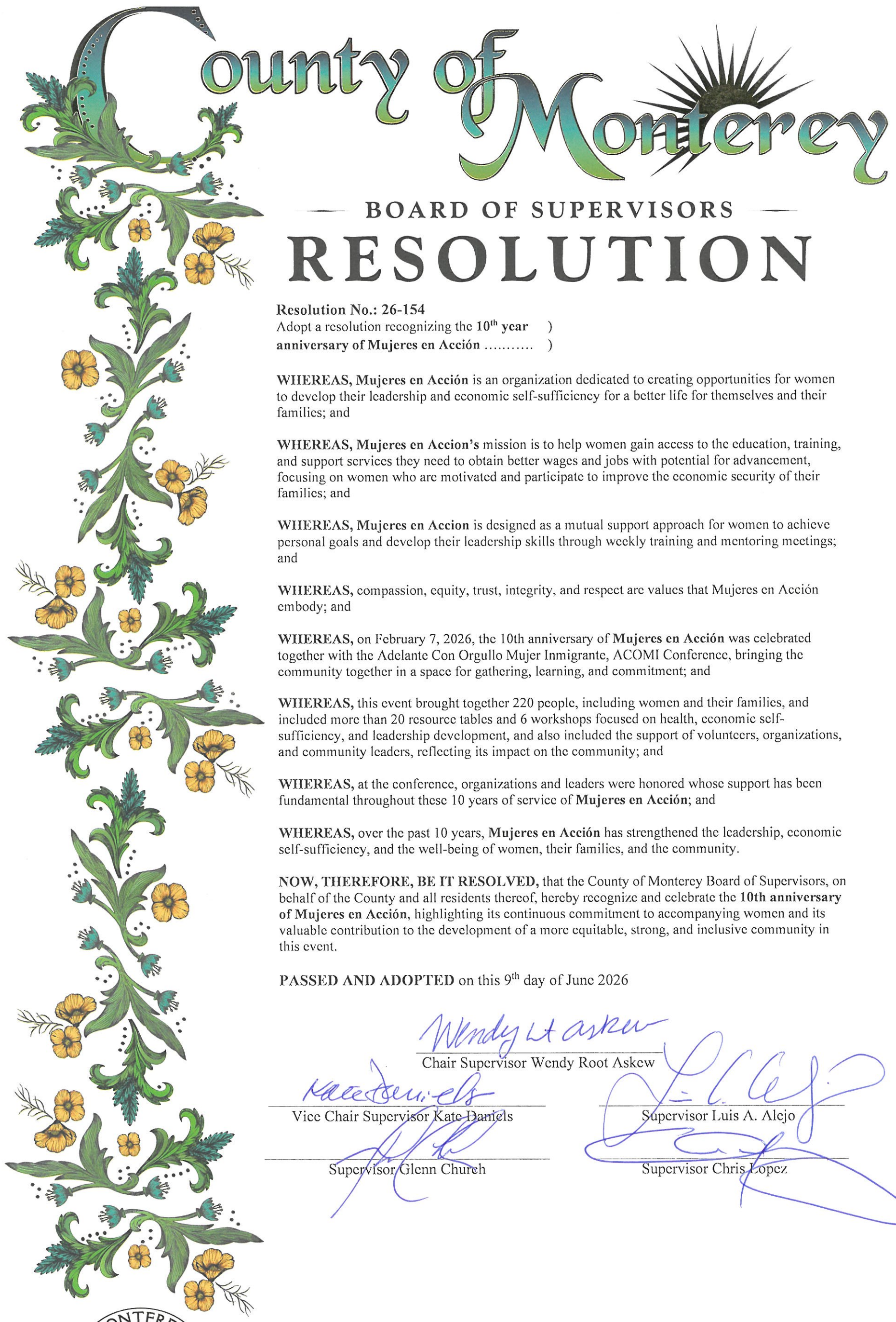

WHEREAS, **Mujeres en Acción's** mission is to help women gain access to the education, training, and support services they need to obtain better wages and jobs with potential for advancement, focusing on women who are motivated and participate to improve the economic security of their families; and

WHEREAS, **Mujeres en Acción** is designed as a mutual support approach for women to achieve personal goals and develop their leadership skills through weekly training and mentoring meetings; and

WHEREAS, on February 7, 2026, the 10th anniversary of **Mujeres en Acción** was celebrated together with the Adelante Con Orgullo Mujer Inmigrante, ACOMI Conference, bringing the community together in a space for gathering, learning, and commitment; and

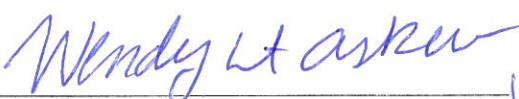

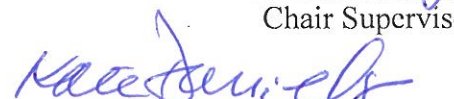
WHEREAS, at the conference, organizations and leaders were honored whose support has been fundamental throughout these 10 years of service of **Mujeres en Acción**; and

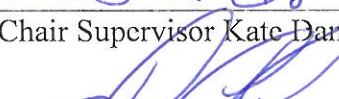

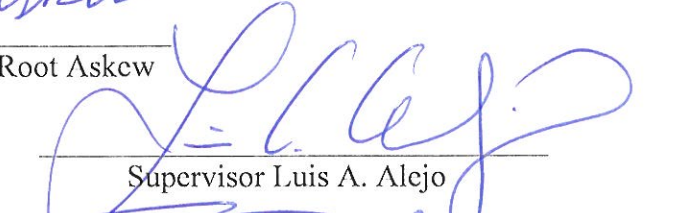

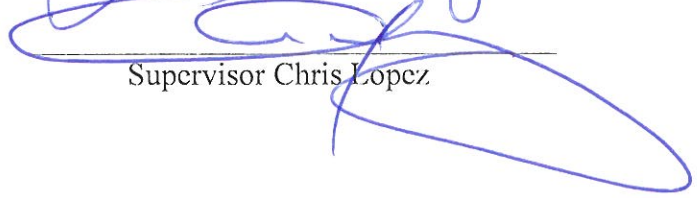
