**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF MONTEREY, STATE OF CALIFORNIA,
AMENDING SECTION 12.24.020 OF THE MONTEREY COUNTY CODE RELATING
TO STOP INTERSECTIONS.**

County Counsel Summary

This ordinance amends section 12.24.020 of the Monterey County Code to establish an all-way stop intersection at Guadalupe Street and Pico Avenue in the Carmel area in the unincorporated area of the County of Monterey.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND FINDINGS. Pursuant to Article XI, section 7 of the California Constitution, the County of Monterey may adopt and enforce ordinances and regulations not in conflict with general laws to protect and promote the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens. California Vehicle Code section 21354 authorizes the County of Monterey to designate any County highways as through highways, and erect stop signs at all entrances thereto or to designate any intersection under its exclusive jurisdiction as a stop intersection and erect stop signs at one or more entrances thereto.

SECTION 2. Section 12.24.020 of the Monterey County Code is amended to add the following paragraph:

Intersection of **Guadalupe Street and Pico Avenue**, stops required at all four entrances to the intersection.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective on the thirty-first day following its adoption.


