Board Order

A motion was made by Supervisor Luis A. Alejo, seconded by Supervisor Chris Lopez to:

a. Consider the recommendations from the Standing Committee Appointment Process Ad Hoc related to the rotation process and approved the proposed 2-year committee term over a 10-year cycle rotation system with the following amendments to ensure continuity and a balance of authority.:

Capital Improvement Committee: To ensure the same two supervisors do not simultaneously dominate both the Budget and Capital Improvement committees, a district change was approved. District 4 will serve on Capital Improvement for the 26–27 term (replacing District 1), and District 1 will take over the seat for the 28–29 term (replacing District 4);

Economic Development & Equal Opportunity Committees: A change was approved between Districts 2 and 4 for the 26–27 term. For those first two years, District 2 will sit on the Economic Development Committee (replacing District 4), and District 4 will take the seat on the Equal Opportunity Committee (replacing District 2); and

b. Directed staff to update the rotation schedule and to return to the Board on Tuesday, January 27, 2026, for formal ratification as part of the 2026 board assignments
