Board Order

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Upon consensus the Board:

Received a report on the adoption of an urgency ordinance placing a moratorium on new Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) in the unincorporated areas of Monterey County while new policies and regulations for BESS are developed; and

Directed staff to look for funding to hire a consultant to outsource this, in order to get, a draft ordinance back to the Board in a timely manner. This matter is to come back to the Board by January for a status update with a realistic timeline within less than a year of what can be accomplished.

The Board stated there are examples out there, as well as safety protocols that have been adopted recently by other counties which the consultants can use as a reference.


