a. Increase appropriations by \$800,000 in the Sheriff's Inmate Medical Programs, SHE004-001-2300-8237-6610, financed by increased revenue (operating transfer in) of \$800,000 from the Health & Welfare Realignment Fund, HEA013-025-4000-8424-7614 (4/5ths vote required);

b. Transfer appropriations of \$800,000 from the Sheriff's Inmate Medical Programs, SHE004-001-2300-8237-6610 to Sheriff's Office Administration and Enforcement Operations Bureau, SHE001-001-2300-8242-6111 (4/5ths vote required);

c. Increase appropriations by \$800,000 in the Health & Welfare Realignment Fund, HEA013-025-4000-8424-7614, financed by increased revenue (operating transfer in) of \$800,000 from the Health & Welfare Realignment Fund, HEA013-025-4000-8424-5940 (4/5ths vote required);

d. Increase appropriations by \$500,000 in the Sheriff's Office Administration and Enforcement Operations Bureau, SHE001-001-2300-8242-6113, financed by \$500,000 in supplemental law enforcement revenue in the Sheriff's Office Administration and Enforcement Operations Bureau,

SHE001-001-2300-8242-5570 (4/5ths vote required);

e. Transfer appropriations of \$200,000 from the Sheriff's Custody Operations Bureau, SHE003-001-2300-8238-6613 to the Coroner's Division,

SHE002-001-2300-8226-6608 (4/5ths vote required); and

f. Transfer appropriations of \$500,000 from the Sheriff's Custody Operations Bureau, SHE003-001-2300-8238-6613 to the Sheriff's Office Administration and Enforcement Operations Bureau, SHE001-001-2300-8242-6222 (4/5ths vote required).

- c. Authorize the County Administrative Office and the Auditor Controller to incorporate the budget changes in the FY 2014-15 Adopted Budget.
