WHEREAS, Monterey Bay Unified Air Pollution Control District was officially established on July 1, 1974 when the Monterey and Santa Cruz County Unified Air Pollution Control District merged with the San Benito County Air Pollution Control District to form the Monterey Bay Unified Air Pollution Control District; and,

WHEREAS, Monterey Bay Unified Air Pollution Control District is responsible for air monitoring, permitting, enforcement, long-range air quality planning, regulatory development, education and public information activities related to air pollution, as required by the California Clean Air Act and Amendments and the Federal Clean Air Act and Amendments; and,
