WHEREAS, there are currently more than 588,000 people with Alzheimer's living in the state of California, over 5,000 of whom are in Monterey County, and additionally another 15,000 caregivers in Monterey County who are caring for a loved one with Alzheimer's; and

WHEREAS, researchers are making great progress in developing ways to accurately diagnose and treat Alzheimer's disease, and we need to accelerate the pace of that research in order to have a disease-altering treatment in the next 15 years; and

WHEREAS, the Alzheimer's Association is proclaiming June 2015 as National Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Month and June 21, 2015 as *The Longest Day*, while asking residents of Monterey County to visit the website at www.actionalz.org to learn more about Alzheimer's, and to become part of the effort to combat this disease; and
