PROCLAMATION TERMINATING A LOCAL EMERGENCY BY THE MONTEREY COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the California Emergency Services Act (Government Code section 8630,et seq.) establishes procedures for proclaiming emergencies and for responding promptly to the needs that arise during emergencies; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.68.060 of the Monterey County Code and Section 8630 of the Government Code empower the to proclaim the existence of a local emergency and

WHEREAS, due to a failure in the culvert system underneath Moss Landing Road, seawater intrusion through the Moro Cojo Slough occurred and contamination threatened the critical groundwater resources around the Slough; and

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2015, this Board adopted Resolution No. 15-101 Proclamation of Local Emergency; and

WHEREAS, periodic reports consistent with law have been made; and

WHEREAS, based on information provided to him within the appropriate period required by law, and in the absence/unavailability of the Board to meet, the County Administrative Officer terminated the emergency effective January 15, 2016, which date was the earliest possible date warranted by the conditions; and

WHEREAS, based on information provided to the Board it appears that sufficient temporary improvement have been made so as to alleviate the emergency conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors in and for the County of Monterey as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct.
- 2. The actions of the County Administrative Officer are hereby confirmed and ratified.
- 3. The local emergency proclaimed by Resolution No. 15-101 is hereby terminated.
