A motion was made by Supervisor Wendy Root Askew, seconded by Supervisor Mary L. Adams to:

- a. Receive a presentation from the Health Department, Public Health Bureau on current tobacco use prevention efforts and implementation of evidence-based and best practices to address youth vaping; and b. Approve allocation of the JUUL settlement funds in the amount of \$1,487,999 to Public Health Bureau to be utilized in FY 2024-25 for \$496,000, FY 2025-26 for \$496,000, and FY 2026-27 for \$495,999;
- c. Direct staff to include Public Health Bureau's budget augmentation request in the amount of \$496,000 funded by the JUUL settlement in the FY 2024-25 recommended budget (4/5 vote required); and bring this matter back during the Budget Hearings with the directed adjustments provided by the Board and the additional data requested.
