WHEREAS, Charles J. McKee, hereinafter referred to as County Counsel, possesses the necessary skills and expertise needed for County Counsel and will provide those skills to County.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. Appointment

County hereby appoints Charles J. McKee to be County Counsel for the County of Monterey pursuant to California Government Code § 27640 et seq., effective April 28, 2003

2. Scope of Services

County Counsel shall perform all duties set forth in the laws of the United States, California and Monterey County and such other duties as may by assigned from time to time by the Board of Supervisors.

3. <u>Compensation</u>

County shall provide the following compensation:

- A. The annual salary for County Counsel shall be \$141,000.00 paid in installments and in the same frequency as other County employees.
- Medical, dental and vision coverage with a health stipend to be provided by County consistent with other top management, but no less than \$762.00 per month.

4. Moving Allowance

In recognition of relocating to Monterey County, County Counsel shall receive from County a moving allowance of \$5,000.00 paid in a lump sum with his first paycheck.

5. <u>Performance Evaluation</u>

At least annually and in closed session, the Board of Supervisors shall complete a performance evaluation of County Counsel and discuss the same with County Counsel. The Board Chair shall sign all written evaluations. At the Board and/or County Counsel's discretion, the Board may conduct quarterly or more frequent performance evaluations.

Term of Agreement and Termination

Pursuant to Government Code § 27641, the term of appointment is four (4) years, subject to termination as provided for in the statute.

7. Complete Agreement

This agreement is the full and complete agreement regarding the appointment and employment of Charles J. McKee as County Counsel for Monterey County. Copies of this agreement are as good as and may be used in the same way as the original.

Now therefore, the parties agree as follows:

1. REAPPOINTMENT:

2. SCOPE OF SERVICES:

- C. Automobile allowance equal to other top management, but no less than \$375.00 per month;
- D. All other benefits received by top management;
- E. County Counsel shall receive future increases in salary and benefits consistent with other top management or as negotiated between the parties.

4. PERFORMANCE EVALUATIONS:

Six months from the date of this contract and at least annually thereafter, the County of Monterey Board of Supervisors shall complete a performance evaluation of County Counsel and discuss issues of concern, including compensation. At the discretion of either party, the Board may conduct more frequent evaluations.

5. TERM AND TERMINATION:

The term of this agreement and termination shall be governed by Government Code section 27641.

6. COMPLETE AGREEMENT, GOVERNING LAW AND COPIES:

This is the full and complete agreement regarding appointment of Charles J. McKee as County Counsel for the County of Monterey. California law shall govern this agreement. Copies of the agreement are as good as and may be used in the same way as an original.
