Board Order

Upon motion of Supervisor Salinas, seconded by Supervisor Phillips and carried by those members present, the Board of Supervisors hereby:

- a. Approved Natividad Medical Center to increase the total project cost approved by the Board of Supervisors for \$1,156,036 for The Medical Office Buildout -Floor One by \$1,059,716 to a revised total project cost of \$2,215,752.; and
- b. Approved Natividad Medical Center to increase the total project cost approved by the Board of Supervisors for \$800,000 for The Building 400 - Mechanical Upgrade by \$44,381 to a revised total project cost of \$844,381; and
- c. Awarded an agreement in the total amount of \$2,604,675 for the construction component to Tombleson Inc. the lowest responsible and responsive base bidder, for Natividad Medical Center for the above mentioned projects;
- d. Approved the Performance and Payment Bonds executed and provided by Tombleson Inc.; and
- e. Authorized a contingency (not to exceed 10% of the contract amount) to provide funding for approved contract change order; and
- f. Authorized the Purchasing Manager at NMC to execute the contract and subject to the terms of the Public Contract Code, approve change order to the contract that do not exceed 10% of the original contract amount, and do not significantly change the scope of work.
