WHEREAS, on August 27, 2024, the County of Monterey Board of Supervisors (“Board”) adopted Ordinance Number 5423 that amended the Monterey County Code and to provide for a local transactions and use tax;

WHEREAS, the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration (“Department”) administers and collects the transactions and use taxes for all applicable jurisdictions within the State;

WHEREAS, the Department will be responsible to administer and collect the transactions and use tax for the County of Monterey (“County”);

WHEREAS, the Department requires that the County enter into a “Preparatory Agreement” and an “Administration Agreement” prior to implementation of said taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Department requires that the Board authorize the Preparatory Agreement and the Administration Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the County of Monterey Board of Supervisors as follows:

The “Preparatory Agreement” attached as Exhibit A and the “Administrative Agreement” attached as Exhibit B are hereby approved and the County Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to execute each agreement.
