Background / Concerns

- Board Referral No 2022.05
 - Concerns about roadside parking on Madison Lane in the unincorporated community of Boronda
 - Possible traffic hazards caused by one-lane traffic, due to parked vehicles
 - Perform traffic engineering study
 - Seek to apply MCC 12.28.010 to prohibit parking

Process

- Perform traffic engineering study
 - Inclusive of public outreach/engagement for full understanding
- Prepare Ordinance
- Resources Required
 - Staffing – PWFP and County Counsel
 - Cost - \$15,000 (estimated) labor and materials
- Timing
 - Return to the Board June 2022 (target)
 - Urgency Ordinance due to health/safety concerns, compresses timelines

Challenges

- Coordination with stakeholders
- Community outreach/engagement

Recommendations / Options

- Continue with Process (Staff Recommendation)
- Modify Referral/Request
- Rescind Referral/Request
