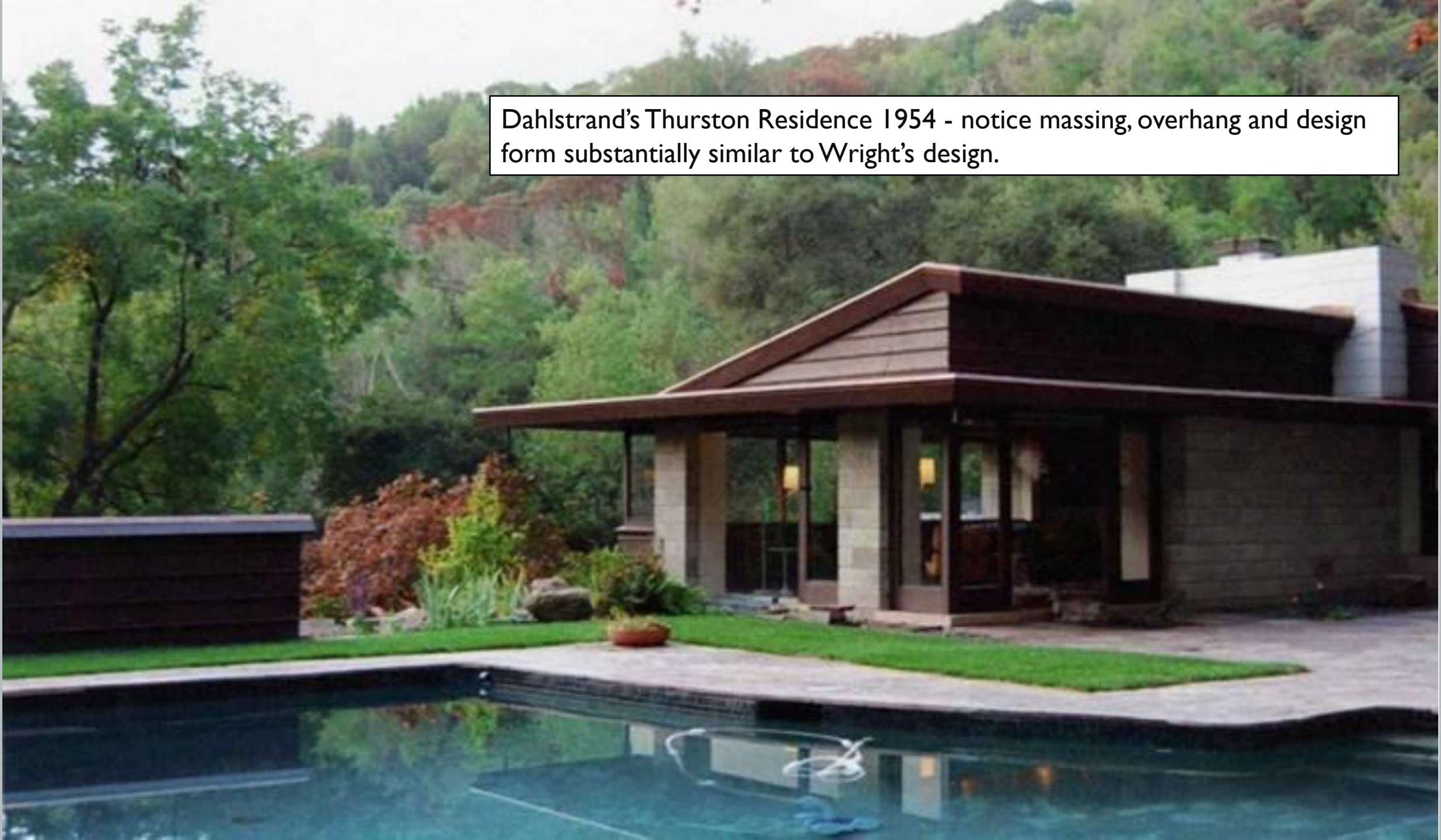


WAS OLOF DAHLSTRAND A

Wright designed home with corner gable roof element.

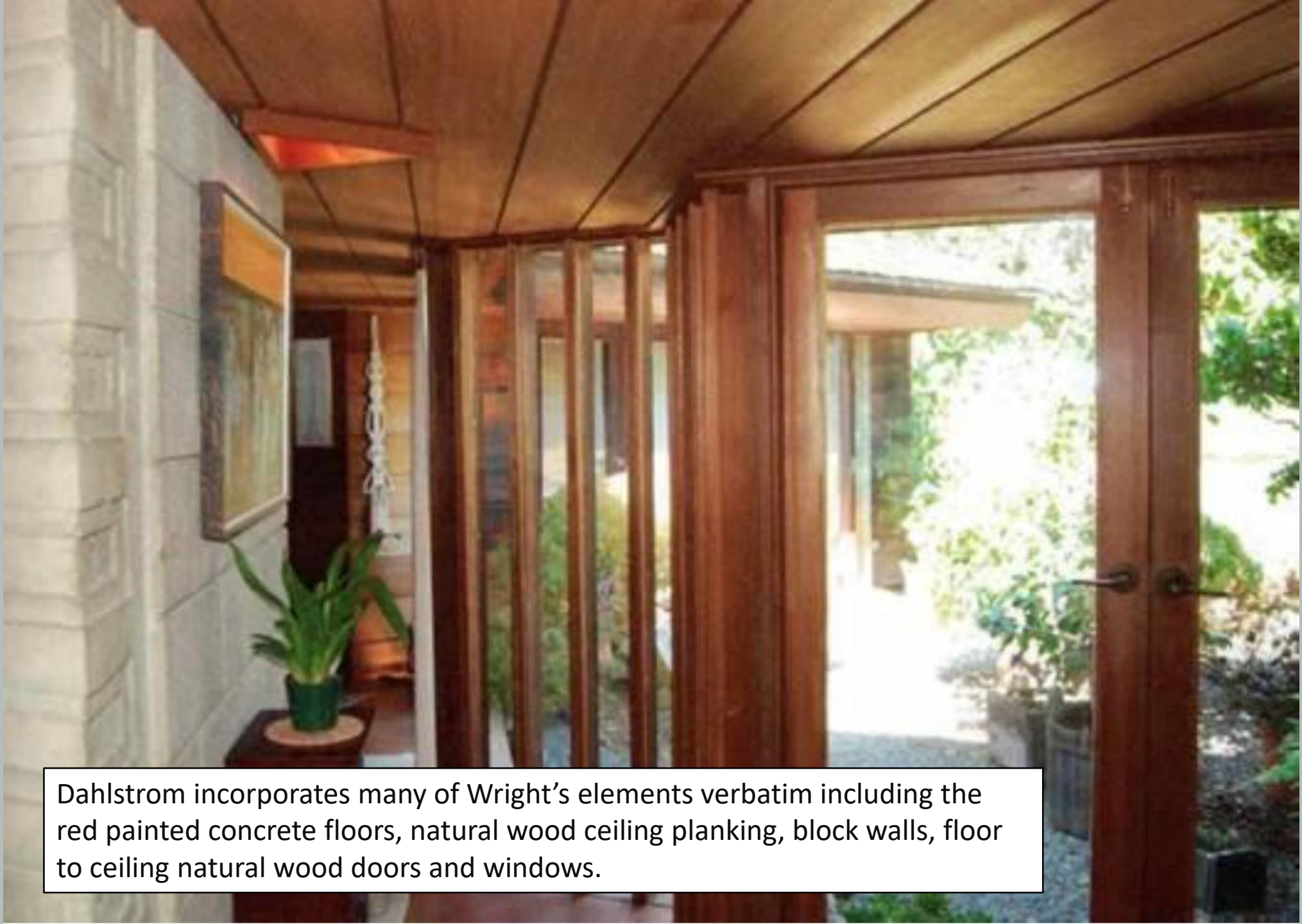




Dahlstrand designed home with corner gable roof element seen in many Wright designed homes.

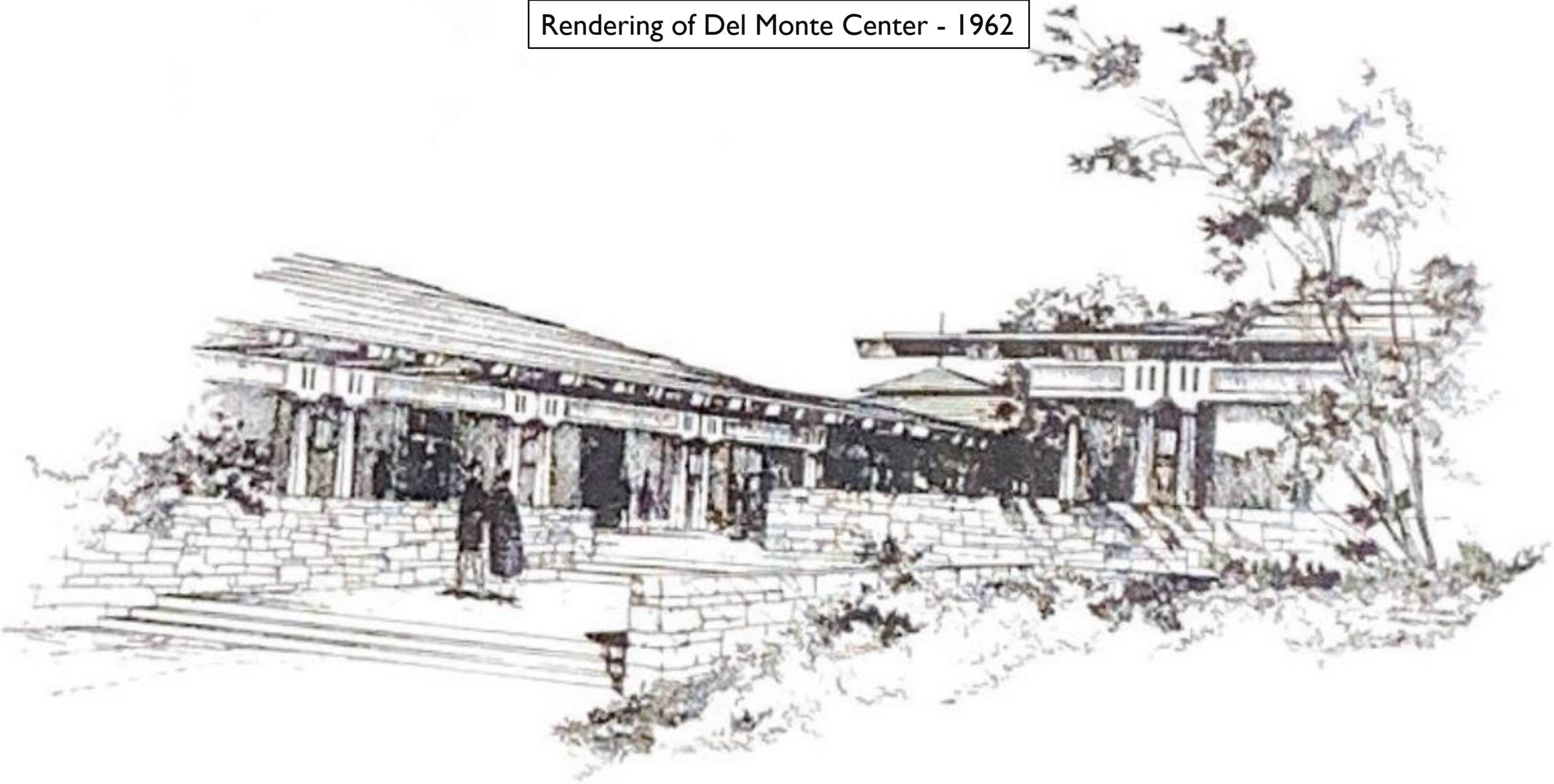
