- Child Advocacy Center (KC) Program, April 1, 2026 March 31, 2027
- Innovative Response to Marginalized Victims of Crime (KI) Program, January 1, 2026 December 31, 2026
- Family Justice Center (FJ) Program, April 1, 2026 March 31, 2028; and,

WHEREAS, the Programs are funded in part from funds made available from and administered by the California Office of Emergency Services (CalOES); and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to authorize the District Attorney to submit grant proposals for the Programs, and to execute grant award agreements therefore; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors recognizes that as a condition of receiving such grants the County must agree that the State of California and the Office of Emergency Services will have no liability arising from the performance of any grant award agreement, and that the grant funds may be used only to implement the Programs and not supplant other expenditures controlled by the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey as follows:

- The District Attorney of Monterey County or its designee is authorized, on behalf of the Board of Supervisors, to submit proposals to the California Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) and is authorized to execute on behalf of the Board of Supervisors the Grant Award Agreements, including any extension and sub-award amendments for:
- Victim Witness Assistance (VW) Program, October 1, 2025 September 30, 2026
- Unserved/Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach (UV) Program, January 1, 2026 -December 31, 2026
- Child Advocacy Center (KC) Program, April 1, 2026 March 31, 2027

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- Innovative Response to Marginalized Victims of Crime (KI) Program, January 1, 2026 December 31, 2026
- Family Justice Center (FJ) Program, April 1, 2026 March 31, 2028
 - 2. The Board of Supervisors agrees that any liability arising out of the performance of a grant award agreement in performance of the program detail in paragraph 1 above, shall be the responsibility of the County and the District Attorney's Office, and not of the State of California nor the Office of Emergency Services, which disclaim responsibility for any such liability.
 - 3. Any grant funds received shall be used solely to implement the programs detailed in paragraph 1 above, and not be used to supplant other expenditures controlled by the Board of Supervisors.
