Pursuant to the requirements of Public Resources Code Section 21167.5, this letter will serve as notice that Evergreen Financial Group LLC will commence litigation against the County of Monterey.

The litigation will challenge the County's approval of Application PLN1230706, a Combined Development Permit consisting of: 1) a Coastal Administrative Permit to allow the construction of a new 1,938 square foot residential addition (893 square foot second-story master bedroom addition; 1,010 square foot main level garage addition; 35 square foot elevator addition), 197.5 square foot upper-level deck addition and interior remodel to an existing residence; 2) a Coastal Development Permit to allow development within 750 feet of positive archaeological resource; and 3) a Design Approval (Project) located on property at 173 Spindrift Road, Carmel, California (APN 241-301-014-000), including County's environmental determination that the project is categorically exempt from CEQA review.

The litigation will be commenced because the actions listed in the preceding paragraph do not comply with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act. The action will also include an action pursuant to the California Coastal Act.
