Scope of Work Monterey County Health Department (MCHD)

Community Violence and Reproductive Health among Youth in Salinas, California

The County of Monterey on behalf of the Monterey County Health Department has partnered with RTI for involvement of key personnel as co-investigators and local liaisons for this research project. The Monterey County Health Department will act as fiscal agent and partner with Natividad Medical Center to fulfill the grant requirements. Duties of the Key Personnel assigned are described as follows:

John Silva, MD, Co-Investigator

As a co-investigator on this proposal, Dr. Silva will contribute 5% FTE or .6 calendar months effort in years one through four. In this capacity, Dr. Silva will participate in quarterly research team meetings and review study procedures and instruments as they are developed. He will be involved in discussing findings from the formative research and considering their application to the quantitative questionnaires that will be administered through the prospective cohort study. He will also participate in the project's community advisory board and help to resolve any challenges that might arise at the Family Medicine Clinic (Natividad Medical Center) with which he is affiliated, when teens seek clinical referrals for reproductive health services. In year 4, Dr. Silva will be involved in reviewing and providing input on analyses as well as in dissemination and publication of findings.

Linda McGlone, MPH, Project Lead

As the Project Lead at the Monterey County Health Department, Ms. McGlone will contribute 20% FTE or 2.4 calendar months effort in each of the proposed four years. In this capacity, Ms. McGlone will facilitate study start-up activities by continuing to build local support for the study through relevant community working groups and Health Department-led initiatives. She will serve as co-chair of the study's community advisory board, which she will help convene. She will participate in regular team meetings and provide input on study procedures and instruments. As study data become available for analysis, Ms. McGlone will participate in reviewing and providing input on analyses as well as in developing dissemination materials, both community reports and presentations as well as scientific publications.
