WHEREAS Team Coast Guard, consisting of Coast Guard Station Monterey Active Duty personnel, Reserves and Division six Auxiliaries, have worked hard all year to increase boating safety awareness in Monterey County; and

WHEREAS Team Coast Guard has conducted more than 2,000 patrol hours, 952 free Vessel Safety Checks on boats and personal water craft in Monterey County, taught 250 hours of “About Boating Safely” classes to the public, and educated more than 3,000 members of the public by interacting with them during public events; and

WHEREAS Team Coast Guard has made several boating safety presentations to local elementary schools and sponsored public visits to the Coast Guard Station to emphasize boating safety; and

WHEREAS Team Coast Guard has assisted numerous boaters in distress during maritime patrols conducted on Monterey Bay; and

WHEREAS Team Coast Guard will continue its efforts to patrol Monterey Bay, educate the boating public by offering boater safety classes, conduct free Vessel Safety Checks, promote safe boating, and encourage the wearing of life jackets; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Monterey County on behalf of the County and all citizens thereof, hereby designate the week of May 20 through May 26, 2017 as “**National Safe Boating Week**” in Monterey County, and urge ALL users of inland lakes, rivers, and the Pacific Coastal Area to safeguard their lives by not drinking alcohol while boating, by attending a safe boating course, and by adopting the slogan of “Wear It”, that is- always wear a life preserver while boating!
