- a. Reviewed Previously Adopted Proclamation of Local Emergency due to the conditions of saltwater intrusion into groundwater sources and inundation near the Moro Cojo Slough, causing conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property nearby; and
- b. Authorized and directed the RMA Director for Monterey County to prepare and record a Notice of Exemption pursuant to CEQA for any work necessary at the slough flap gates to implement a temporary solution on an emergency basis as maybe authorized by the appropriate Resource Agencies.
