- a. Received a presentation on additional consultations with Monterey County Employees on approaches to avoid constructive receipt by creation of a "Stand Alone" Program for the Election of Cash out of Vacation / Annual Leave / Paid Time Off (PTO);
- b. Directed that staff return with a recommendation to amend the County's Personnel Policies and Practices Resolution to add provisions for the Election of Cash Out of Vacation /Annual Leave/ Paid Time Off (PTO) that provides immediate protection from constructive receipt; and
- c. Directed that staff pursue an Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Private Letter Ruling on the validity of an emergency provision request, developed as much as possible with bargaining units and unrepresented units, to the Cash Out of Vacation/Annual Leave/PTO Stand Alone Program.
