

Formation & Function of CSA 66

Active Services / Assessment History

- CSA 66 Oak Tree Views (formerly known as Las Lomas-Monterra Ranch Views) established 1997
- 42 parcels
- Annual assessment fund service needs:
 - Streetlighting, Storm Drain Maintenance, Street & Sidewalk Maintenance, Parks/Recreation/Parkway (Open Space & Tot Lot)
- Assessments maximum per 1997 agreement is \$1,000
 - Current assessment \$408.96 per year (since 2006)
 - Proposed assessment \$606.58 per year, then CPI-based increase for 2 years

Financial History & Long-Term Sustainability

- Estimated ending fund balance at end of FY 2018-19: \$15,159
- Engineer's Report recommends operating/capital reserve of \$19,000 for first year of increase.

Assessment Funds:

- Annual maintenance
 - Mowing, storm drain, tot lot, trees = \$2,000-\$7,000 annually
- Large-scale projects
 - Road repairs in FY18, FY16, FY14, FY03
- FY 21-22 Completion of Condition Assessment Report
 - Identify infrastructure needs
 - Development capital improvement project list
 - Recommendations for future increases to fund annual maintenance while building reserves for future CIP projects
