

RESOLUTION NO. 13-204 C.S.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEREY

AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF MONTEREY ALLOWING USAGE OF A MECHANICAL BAY AT THE CITY OF MONTEREY CORPORATE YARD

WHEREAS, the City of Monterey and the County of Monterey have a collaborative interest in entering in shared services agreements where both parties would benefit;

WHEREAS, the County of Monterey desires to enter into a license agreement for their use of a vehicle bay from the City of Monterey at the corporate yard in order to perform maintenance on their Sheriff patrol cars;

WHEREAS, as part of the agreement, the County of Monterey agrees to pay the City of Monterey \$7,200 per year for the use of one vehicle bay, certain City equipment, and access to the crew room at the City corporate yard; and

WHEREAS, the City of Monterey has determined that the proposed action is not a project as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)(CCR, Title 14, Chapter 3 ("CEQA Guidelines), Article 20, Section 15378).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEREY that the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute a 1-year initial term agreement, with a maximum of five 1-year extensions, as the capacity and resources of Monterey will allow and at City's sole discretion, to provide the County of Monterey use of one vehicle bay, certain City equipment, and access to the crew room at the City corporation yard.


