

AMENDMENT No. 1 TO AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN COUNTY OF MONTEREY & QUESTYS SOLUTIONS

THIS AMENDMENT is made to the AGREEMENT dated September 3, 2019 (“AGREEMENT”) for the provision of the with Questys Solutions for maintenance and technical support used for Digital Information Management Program for Monterey County by and between Questys Solutions, hereinafter called “Vendor” and the County of Monterey, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as “County”.

WHEREAS, the County and Vendor wish to increase the amount by \$12,935 to provide for the purchase of additional Microsoft Office Integration Module and associated annual subscription fees from May 1, 2020 through August 31, 2022; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Customer and Vendor hereby agree to amend the AGREEMENT in the following manner:

1. The AGREEMENT shall be amended by adding Microsoft Office Integration Module and annual subscriptions to this Amendment No. 1, adding \$12,935 to the existing agreement amount of \$376,124.08 for a revised total amount of \$389,059.08.
2. The Agreement shall be amended by adding Exhibit A, Microsoft Office Integration Module order form.
3. Except as provided herein, all remaining terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement are unchanged and unaffected by this AMENDMENT No. 1 and shall continue in full force and effect as set forth in the Agreement.
4. A copy of this AMENDMENT No. 1 shall be attached to the original Agreement.
