**WHEREAS**, the County of Monterey Capital Improvement Program Five-Year Plan for Fiscal Years 2026/27 through 2030/31 (hereinafter CIP) sets forth public projects essential to maintain and improve County public facilities and facilitate the orderly implementation of the County General Plan;

**WHEREAS**, the County of Monterey Department of Public Works, Facilities, and Parks (PWFP) works with County Departments to update the CIP on a yearly basis to reflect County needs, priorities, and available funding;

**WHEREAS**, on March 17, 2026, the Capital Improvement Committee (CIC) reviewed the draft CIP;

**WHEREAS**, on May 26, 2026, the Budget Committee (BC) reviewed the draft CIP;

**WHEREAS**, on June 10, 2026, the Planning Commission (PC) adopted a resolution finding that the CIP conforms to and is consistent with the 2010 Monterey County General Plan, the Local Coastal Program, and 1982 General Plan as applicable;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Monterey County Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the County of Monterey Capital Improvement Program Five-Year Plan for Fiscal Years 2026/27 through 2030/31.


