### RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors:

### SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

California Elections Code Sections 10002 and 10400 et seq., provide that a city or district may by resolution request the Board of Supervisors to authorize the Registrar of Voters to consolidate and provide election services relating to the conduct of an election. The services requested consist generally of establishing voting precincts and polling places, preparing and distributing ballots and voting materials, canvassing the voted returns, certifying election results and issuing certificates of election, and all other proceedings incidental to and connected with the election.


OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:


