Adopt a Resolution to:

Approve and authorize the Monterey County Sheriff's Office to accept a matching Grant award from the United States Department of Justice Bureau of Justice Assistance in the amount of \$600,000 to partly fund the Axon Body Worn Camera Program.

WHEREAS, The Monterey County Sheriff's Office is requesting approval from the Board to accept a Grant award from the United States Department of Justice Bureau of Justice Assistance in the amount of \$600,000 to partly fund the Axon Body Worn Camera Program. This amount will be spent in the next three fiscal years of which \$349,800 was included in the FY2024-2025 Recommended Budget and the remaining \$250,200 will be spent in the following next two fiscal years. The awarded grant can be utilized to provide funding over a 3-year period from the award date and requires \$600,000 funding match during the 3-year grant period as well. All grant funds must be expended prior to the conclusion of September 2026; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Monterey County Board of Supervisors hereby resolved to approve the following:

Approve and authorize the Monterey County Sheriff's Office to accept a matching Grant award from the United States Department of Justice Bureau of Justice Assistance in the amount of \$600,000 to partly fund the Axon Body Worn Camera Program.


