WHEREAS the County of Monterey Board of Supervisors established the Community Restorative Justice Commission on September 26, 2000 to provide a more comprehensive and integrated approach to delinquency prevention and crime response, under the principles of restorative justice for long term healing, restoration and prevention;

WHEREAS the Community Restorative Justice Commission presently consists of the Chief Probation Officer, the District Attorney, one member of the Board and 14 members appointed by the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Community Restorative Justice Commission's membership shall be increased 18 members as detailed in Exhibit A.
