Resolution recognizing the week of September 17-23, 2024 as **Constitution Week**

**WHEREAS**, September 17, 2024, marks the two hundred and thirty-seventh anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the privilege and duty of the American people to commemorate this anniversary with appropriate ceremonies and activities, reflecting on the significance of this document that embodies the principles of our government; and

**WHEREAS**, the Constitution stands as a testament to the enduring principles of freedom, democracy, and the rule of law that have guided our nation for over two centuries; and

**WHEREAS**, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary and to encourage all citizens to reaffirm the ideals the Framers of the Constitution envisioned in 1787 by vigilantly protecting the freedoms guaranteed to us.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Monterey County Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the County and all its citizens thereof, does hereby proclaim the week of September 17 through 23 as *Constitution Week* in Monterey County, and urges all citizens to study the Constitution and reflect on the privilege of being an American with all the rights and responsibilities that come with this privilege.
