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Board Order

Upon motion of Supervisor Alejo, seconded by Supervisor Salinas and carried by those members present, the Board of Supervisors hereby:

- a. Received an update on Monterey County's Pilot Project for the Remaining Uninsured; and
- b. Received a proposal for providing expanded full scope primary care and ambulatory specialty services which would provide services including laboratory, diagnostic imaging, and limited generic drugs for \$1.8 million for 2,500 individuals; and
- c. Provided direction to staff to pursue funding through Natividad Medical Center (NMC) enterprise fund or other NMC sources and report back half way through the fiscal year on how the expanded pilot project is working. If there are any major changes to federal healthcare law in the future, that the Board revisit this in the pilot project at that time.


