

# Application for Order Authorizing Destruction of Records

TO: Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey

4. No copies of the records exist.
5. These records are all in excess of 2 years old in compliance with Government Code Section 26202.

The subject files involve original Parks Department cash receipts generated from the daily transactions for vehicle entrance fees and private vessel use fees at Monterey County parks and facilities.
