A motion was made by Supervisor Glenn Church, seconded by Supervisor Luis A. Alejo to:

- a. Receive a presentation and accept the Santa Rita Creek Drainage Study through Bolsa Knolls; and
- b. Directed staff to come back in 60 days with a more detailed plan with refined options as to:

Clear Costs and Project Details for more complete estimates and plans for:

Sediment removal (including possibly major cleanup);

Culvert upgrades (e.g., Paul Ave & Rogge Rd);

Detention / retention basins upstream; and

Ongoing maintenance needs.

Governance and Funding Structure staff must evaluate how the work will be managed and paid for, including:

Expanding or modifying an existing County Service Area (CSA);

Creating a new special district;

Forming a Joint Powers Authority (JPA); and

Comparing costs and efficiency of each option

Immediate Actions identify what can be done right away, especially:

Selective vegetation removal (since it may not require permits)
