Referral Title: Monterey County Fracking Ban

Referral Purpose: The purpose of this referral is to draft an ordinance that would prohibit fracking in Monterey County.

Brief Referral Description: Hydraulic fracturing, otherwise known as fracking, is the process of injecting liquid into shale beds at high pressure in order to free up petroleum resources, such as oil or natural gas. The Board of Supervisors considered directing staff to prepare an interim ordinance for a fracking moratorium on March 17, 2015, but voted to reject the proposal with a 3-2 vote.

On November 8, 2016, Measure Z aimed to prohibit fracking as well other restrictions on the oil industry, and was approved by voters with 56% of the vote. The Monterey County Superior Court issued a writ of mandate invalidating the measure primarily on the long established doctrine that state law and regulations preempt a local ballot measure. In 2021, the California Court of Appeal affirmed the trial court's ruling and the California Supreme Court also affirmed on August 3, 2023.

However, the courts did not rule on the fracking ban portion of the measure because there had never been any fracking in Monterey County and there were no plans to use the technique here. The California Supreme Court stated, that fracking "is not an issue here because none of the plaintiffs use, or have any plans to use, such methods." Chevron U.S.A., Inc., et al. v. County of Monterey, et al. (2023).

On September 25, 2024, Governor Gavin Newsom signed Assembly Bill 3233 that authorized local governments to limit or prohibit oil operations, such as fracking. That law went into effect on January 1, 2025.

Since banning fracking was the primary concern by the public in approving Measure Z, this referral now request that our County draft an ordinance that would prohibit fracking in Monterey County. Such a measure will only ensure that fracking will not take place within our County, will fulfill the will of the voters, and will protect future generations in Monterey County and our environment.
