direction to staff on a preferred option regarding the operation of the Permit Streamlining Task Force. Staff has identified three options for the Board to consider:

- a. Take no action, and the Permit Streamlining Task Force would continue to operate as a volunteer private group that advises County staff on land use permit process issues (operation, organization, fees) but has no official role with the County; or
- b. Directed staff to return for formal Board action officially forming a group with Board-appointed members, if the task force desires to become a more formal committee of the County
- c. Take no action, and the Permit Streamlining Task Force decides on its own to disband.
