### Strategic Plan

The Arts Council for Monterey County supports artists, programs, and organizations that preserve culture, create community, promote arts as a universal language, and stimulates the creative economy.

The organization's overarching strategy is to advance social equity through the arts by supporting artists, programs, and organizations that are emerging, under-resourced, or underrepresented.











### **Arts4MC Programs**

Professional Artists in the Schools ("PAS") provides professional artists in the schools with credentialed teachers, and reaching over 25,000 students in 40 partner schools.

32% of Monterey County schools are not providing the mandated visual and performing arts.

89% of Monterey County students are BIPOC.

Arts4Healing provides a creative and expressive outlet for individuals facing physical, emotional or psychological challenges.

Our teaching artists are trained in Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) to provide arts education and programs to at-risk youth, people with disabilities, the homeless, survivors of human trafficking, low-income senior citizens and veterans.

### County of Monterey's Investment in the Arts

Arts4MC currently receives 1.98% of the County's annual transient occupancy tax to focus on three main areas:

# **Economic Impact** of the Arts

Small investment, big returns: \$440,000 investment in the arts in 2022 by the County of Monterey; spending by nonprofit arts and culture organizations generated a total of \$42.7 million in tax revenues

\$475,000 in funding provided for College Arts Scholarships, individual artists and arts organizations this year to build capacity and strengthen our cultural sector.

We prioritize racial equity and have a broad geographic reach into communities of all sizes and needs.







## How the Arts Contribute to Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT)

More than 80% of all attendees to Cali Roots (46,000 attendees) and Monterey Jazz Festival (37,000 attendees) traveled from outside Monterey County, contributing to the transient occupancy tax by staying in hotels and Airbnb's, some in unincorporated Monterey County.
