WHEREAS, John Mount began his career in Monterey County as a Communications Dispatcher I on April 29, 1996 for the Monterey County Emergency Communications Department (MCECD), and steadily rose through the ranks serving as Communications Dispatcher II, Emergency Communications Shift Supervisor and ultimately promoted to Emergency Communications Operations Supervisor in December 10, 2005; and

WHEREAS, John Mount has served as the Fire/EMS Liaison, and MCECD Custodian of Records handling all dispatch and audio record requests from the District Attorney's Office, Law Enforcement agencies and the public for several years including handling all subpoenas for records and appearing in Court to testify to the authentication of the records; and

WHEREAS, John Mount participated in Office of Emergency Services (OES) working groups for emergency and disaster plan development which include: Tsunami Response Plan, Winter Storm Plan, Mass Care & Shelter Plan, Mass Evacuation & Transportation Plan, Mass Fatality Plan, Wildland Evacuation Mapping & Emergency Notification System project and Chempack policy and Mass Casualty Plan for Emergency Medical Services & first responders. He was the Emergency Operations Center Liaison and Communications Unit Leader; attended all trainings, exercises and activations; and was the Department's Terrorist Liaison Officer; and
