Background

Board Referral No 2024.05

- > PWFP maintains a Speed Hump Policy that is implemented by the PWFP's Traffic Engineering section.
 - Petition Process
 - Staff Review
 - Constituents acquire MoCo Encroachment Permit and bear all costs
- Speed hump installation cost ranges from \$12k to \$17k (excludes soft costs)
- BR seeks staff investigate methods to cover or subsidize the costs of installing speed humps in low-income neighborhoods to promote road safety.

Process

- > Define and identify disadvantaged communities.
- Develop framework for analytic factors, prioritization criteria, and selection.
- > Develop application process, and policy amendments as appropriate.
- Develop process for removal of speed humps, for those who do not want them.
- Prepare the necessary project California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). documentation to comply with State and local requirements.
- Acquire funding for these betterments.
- Implement proposal.
- > After trial period, assess the outcomes.
- Note: Due to the sometimes contentious nature of speed humps or other traffic calming countermeasures, staff recommends starting this as a pilot program for a 1 to 2 year period

Process

Resources Required:

- Staffing PWFP, specifically Traffic Engineering; Housing and Community Development (HCD), Office of the County Counsel (OCC), and the County Administrative Office (CAO)
- Cost Costs are not fully-determined at this time, but will consist primarily of staff time and construction costs.
 - > While cost estimates for speed hump construction ranges from \$12,000 to \$17,000, the soft costs of engineering and administration will add to the total project cost.
- Schedule
 - Return to Board January 1, 2025
