WHEREAS, the reform legislation, California Penal Code Section 1001.36 – Diversion of Individuals with Mental Disorders, as amended in January 2019 allows some people with mental health disorders to get treatment when they are charged with a crime. If the defendant successfully completes treatment, the criminal charges may be reduced or dismissed.

WHEREAS, the addition of this .50 FTE Deputy Public Defender II position will enable the Office of the Public Defender to provide legal assistance to indigent adults and juveniles to include development of a holistic approach consistent with the mental health, drug, alcohol, domestic violence, and criminal history.

WHEREAS, the Department will require an increase in FY 2019-20 appropriations and revenues by \$79,469 which is fully reimbursable by grant funding state funded through a collaborative Prop 47 grant with Behavioral Health with anticipated funding for three years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Monterey County Board of Supervisors hereby resolved to approve the following:
