#### Task 3: Hold topical issue forums – Est. \$5,000

Contractor shall identify and hold forums on topical issues affecting businesses in Monterey County. Topical issues will be identified by the Business Council and the Business Advisory Council. MCBC shall prepare and distribute two Economic Reports (Spring & Fall)

**Deliverable:** A minimum of three topical forums with a report of actions to be taken

# Task 4: Maintain the Monterey County Business Portal - Est. \$10,000

In 2005, the Monterey County Business Portal, (Montereycountybusiness.org) was launched.
