## **SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:**

Approval of the Plans and Special Provisions to the Standard Specifications will authorize the Department of Public Works to proceed with advertising for the Crack Seal 2012 Project, Contract No. 12-551225 (Project). The bid opening is set for March 2, 2012, at 2:00 p.m., in the Board of Supervisors' Conference Room 1032, Monterey County Government Center, 168 West Alisal Street, 1st Floor, Salinas, CA 93901. Project construction is estimated to begin in early 2012.

The Project consists of crack sealing the following roads: Blanco Road in the San Miguel Maintenance District, Laureles Grade in the Monterey Maintenance District, Jolon Road and Cattlemen Road in the Greenfield and San Ardo Maintenance Districts. The Project will retard rapid deterioration on these roads by preventing surface water from penetrating the base and will prepare these roads for the chip seal. The proposed project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA guidelines Section 15301(c).

## **OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:**

The Office of the County Counsel, and Risk Management, have reviewed and approved the Special Provisions as to form, and indemnity/insurance language, respectively.

#### **FINANCING:**

Total estimated project cost, including project management, engineering, and construction, is \$342,000. The Project is funded by the General Fund contribution to the Road Fund. There are sufficient appropriations in the Department of Public Works Road Fund (Fund 002, Unit 8195) to finance this Project.
