

# Soledad family helps fund San Lucas Library

Library will be dedicated to Mary Agnes Young

Bud and Paula Sarmiento, with the partnership of their daughters Mary Tadman and Sarah Sarmiento, have donated a six figure dollar amount to cover the expense of building a library and other expenses related to re-establishing library services in San Lucas and the surrounding area.

San Lucas Library, part of the Monterey County Free Library system, was closed recently due to the condition of the building.

Monterey County Librarian Jayanti Addleman contacted the Sarmientos and asked them if they could give her some names of local contacts to spearhead fund raising for the library.

This request occurred at the same time the idea for a stewardship project was on the Sarmientos' minds.

A library project fits perfectly with the interests the Sarmientos hold dear and so they went forward with the gift themselves.

"Paula and I were discussing our stewardship responsibility of handling our good fortune," Bud said.

"One could question why San Lucas is the community's most important and meaningful

reason, is because there is a need," Bud Sarmiento said.

"We would like the library to be dedicated to the memory of Mary Agnes Young, my mother, an early resident of San Lucas," Bud Sarmiento asked of the Foundation.

Bud's mother, Mary Agnes, was born in San Lucas in 1895. Her family had moved to San Lucas from Bradley, and then from San Lucas to Gonzales.

In Gonzales, she was employed as a telephone operator and served as an early librarian for Gonzales. The photo of Mary Agnes is on the wall inside the Gonzales Library.

She and Bud's father, Joseph, moved to Soledad in 1930 and raised three children, Audrey, Harold and Ralph (Bud).

Paula Bianchi Sarmiento and Bud started education in small schools. Paula attended the Soledad Mission School and Bud attended schools in Soledad.

"The closeness of our classmates and teachers in that supporting environment remains in our memories," said Bud. "I recall Miss Himburt, my kindergarten teacher and part time Librarian, in the Soledad school. She took time to tell me, in her kind fashion, about libraries. In summers while I stayed with my older cousins in Salinas, and going into the imposing Library Building on Main Street was special. It was there that I found I could actually take books home.

Paula, too, has precious memories of her time at the Mission School and for those teachers who taught her to read and expose her to the magic of books."

San Lucas Library was first established in the town on June 26, 1916. The first custodian was Mrs. Roy L. Brlay, and she left on Aug. 22, 1917.

Linda Larsen was the Librarian in the tiny building

for almost 30 years, and the last Librarian is Nanette Isenberg, who still works in the county library system.

In an article from the Salinas Californian, Sept. 26, 1987, Larson said, "Romance novels are the most popular books."

"San Lucas, population 160-300, depending on whom you ask," is quoted from the same article. The town doesn't appear to have increased in size over the years, but a library is necessary no matter the size of the population; it rates right up there in importance as does a general store, church and gas station.

"When we started to plan the remodel project for the San Lucas library many problems emerged and we suddenly found we would have to rebuild rather than remodel," said Addleman. "The costs will be well above double what we had anticipated. The community is hurting without the library. When I explained the situation to them, Bud and Paula

never hesitated. They responded with open-hearted generosity. I really cannot thank them enough.

"I am really impressed by our supporters in general. Monterey County Free Libraries serves a large number of people with a relatively small budget. We depend heavily on the Foundation for Monterey County Free Libraries to help us provide many services which we cannot normally afford.

"The San Lucas community is currently being served by a bookmobile that is old and constantly breaks down. We are in the process of getting a new bookmobile, which is being funded in part by a very generous donation from children's author Beverly Cleary. The new bookmobile, which should be here in June will even have computers on board for children to use, which is something I know our San Lucas residents are really missing."

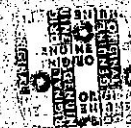
