WHEREAS, Anita McKean has volunteered in numerous community organizations which include Friends of the King City Library since 1985, and treasurer since 1989, Delta Kappa Gamma Society International Advocates for Women educators, Local Chapter Iota Tau which raises funds for scholarships and classroom literacy projects, Grace Lutheran Church-Women of Grace which raises funds for backpacks for local students and scholarships, and Sol Treasures Education Liaison which gives student class tours and art lessons; and

WHEREAS, Anita McKean also volunteered for Girls Inc. of the Central Coast as an adult mentor for the ECHO program at Greenfield High School since 2007 and serves on the fundraising committee for the King City Girls Inc. programs, Mee Memorial Hospital Service League since 2007, King City Lighted Christmas Parade since 2008, Monterey County Agricultural Rural Life Museum at San Lorenzo Park providing school tours, and the fourth grade jamboree; and
