Authorize the Auditor-Controller to amend the Fiscal Year 2021-22 Adopted Budget to increase appropriations and estimated revenues by \$96,000 for the Office of the District Attorney, Fund 001, Appropriation Unit DIS001, financed by the receipt of U.S. Department of Justice funds, 4/5ths vote required.

### RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the Auditor-Controller to amend the Fiscal Year 2021-22 Adopted Budget to increase appropriations and estimated revenues by \$96,000 for the Office of the District Attorney, Fund 001, Appropriation Unit DIS001, financed by the receipt of U.S. Department of Justice funds, 4/5ths vote required.

### SUMMARY:

The Office of the District Attorney (DA) requested permission in June 2021 to apply for a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice (attached) for funding to support the Cold Case Task Force. This multi-year grant, extending from the current fiscal year, through FY 2023-24, provides funding for specialized DNA testing of evidence from criminal cases that have gone "cold" over the years.

### DISCUSSION:

The District Attorney requests your support to authorize the Auditor-Controller to make the necessary changes to the FY 2021-22 Adopted Budget.

### FINANCING:


