Upon motion of Supervisor Parker, seconded by Supervisor Phillips and carried by those members present, the Board of Supervisors hereby:

- a. Introduced, waived reading, and conducted a public hearing to consider adoption of an ordinance amending Section 21.66.050 (Archaeological Resources Standards) of Title 21 (non-coastal zoning) of the Monterey County Code to establish new policies and procedures for the protection of archaeological and tribal cultural resources, and amending Title 2 of the Monterey County Code to add Chapter 2.95 establishing a Native American Advisory Panel consistent with 2010 Monterey County General Plan Goals OS-6 and OS-8; and
- b. Continued public hearing to April 21, 2015 @ 1:30 p.m. to find the ordinance categorically exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act and adopt the ordinance.
