1, 2024 set forth in the attached Exhibit A.)**

THE COUNTY OF MONTEREY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FINDS:

- A. Section 1.40.010 of Chapter 1.40 of Monterey County Code provides that all fees, penalties, refunds, reimbursements and charges of any kind by the County may be specified in the Monterey County Fee Resolution.
- B. The Assessor-Clerk-Recorders' Office has service fees which are appropriate to specify in the Monterey County Master Fee Resolution, Article XIII beginning January 1, 2024.
- C. This action to modify charges to meet operational expenses is statutorily exempt from environmental review [Pub Res. Code sec. 21080 sub. (b)(8)].
- D. The Public Marriage License Fee increase to \$95, the Confidential Marriage License Fee increase to \$100, the Duplicate Marriage License Fee increase to \$55, the Fictitious Business Name Statement Filing Fee increase to \$50, the Abandonment or Withdrawal Fee increase to \$40, the Notary Bond Filing Fee increase to \$50, the Civil Marriage Ceremony Fee increase to \$100, and the Deputy Commissioner of Civil Marriages Fee increase to \$105 are appropriate to specify in the Monterey County Master Fee Resolution, Article XIII Section II effective January 1, 2024.
- E. Any and all adjustments to fees for services reflect no more than the actual and reasonable cost of the service or benefit received by the payor and burdened on the County and reflect no more than the market rate for these services and establish parity with comparable counties. Any discount applicable to these surcharges have a de minimis impact on the departmental budget and implementation of that discount does not result in increased fees or costs for other patrons.
- F. Any and all adjustments to charges for these investigations and services reflect no more than the actual cost of the service or benefit received by the payor.
- G. By definition, these charges are not a 'tax' and are exempt from voter approval pursuant to Article XIII C section 1(e)(1)-(2) of the California Constitution (Prop. 26: charge imposed for specific benefit conferred/privilege/service or product/ provided or granted to the payor).

- I. Article XIII of the Monterey County Fee Resolution is amended, and the Assessor, County Clerk and Recorder set forth in the attachment hereto are hereby adopted.
- II. Unless otherwise specifically amended, all prior resolutions regarding such fees remain as previously approved and are unaffected by this action.
- III. The effective date of the fees approved in this Resolution is January 1, 2024.
- IV. All prior resolutions regarding such fees are hereby repealed.
