

ATTACHMENT B: MENTAL HEALTH EXTENDED TREATMENT SCENARIOS

<i>Scenario 1 – Standard LPS</i>	<i>Event</i>	<i>Notes</i>
W&I § 5150	3-day hold	This is the standard flow when LPS referral is made during 14-day hold.
W&I § 5250	14-day hold	
W&I § 5350	30-day temporary	Proposed conservatee must be provided a minimum of 5-day notice prior to filing.
W&I § 5350	1 year “permanent”	The conservatorship terminates by operation of law 1 year post establishment unless reestablished by petition.
<i>Scenario 2 – Good Faith 30 Day Extension</i>		
W&I § 5150	3-day hold	
W&I § 5250	14-day hold	
W&I § 5270.10	30-day extended	Must be a good faith request that person is not intended to be permanently conserved; otherwise T-Con is a mandatory referral during the 14-day hold.
<i>Scenario 3 – Good Faith Effort Fails</i>		A 30-day extension is done in a good faith effort but patient needs a “permanent” LPS.
W&I § 5150	3-day hold	
W&I § 5250	14-day hold	
W&I § 5270.10	30-day extended	
W&I § 5350	Temporary	Staff realizes 30 days is not going to work. T-Con will run concurrent with § 5270.10; this does not extend the time.
W&I § 5350	1 year “permanent”	Must be heard before expiration of T-Con/extension.
