#### **SUMMARY:**

The Health Department is recommending transfer of 1.0 FTE Management Analyst II position from Clinic Services HEA007-8096 to Health Administration HEA003-8128 to meet current Health Administration needs in the areas of finance, contract management, and facilities and will report directly to the Administration/Fiscal Services Unit (HD Admin).

### **DISCUSSION:**

The transfer of the Management Analyst II position from Clinic Services to Health Administration will ensure current needs in the area of finance, contract management, and facilities are met such as preparation and maintenance of financial reports; and preparing and monitoring contracts, buildings leases, and professional service agreements.
