WHEREAS federal statute requires that each county eligible to receive 2012 Secure Rural Schools and Communities Act (SRSCA) funding must, by September 30, 2012, elect to receive SRSCA funds or elect to receive their 2012 share of the 25% Actual Forest receipts (old 1908 law); and

WHEREAS federal statute requires that those counties electing to receive \$100,000 or more of SRSCA funding in 2012, must elect to set aside 15% or 20% of those funds for Title II and/or Title III Projects; and

WHEREAS federal statute further requires that each county must designate the percentage of those project funds assigned to Title II and Title III for 2012, recognizing that a maximum of 7% can be expended for Title III.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey in the State of California does hereby elect to receive 2012 SRSCA funds in an amount that is less than \$100,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors does hereby elect to use 100 percent (100%) of its 2012 Secure Rural Schools and Communities Act Funds for public roads and schools under Title I of the SRSCA.
