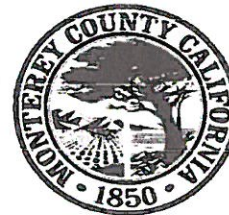



13. I, the undersigned, am authorized to make this application and the following representations on behalf of the applicant organization. I have read and understand the provisions of the Monterey County bingo ordinance. I have received a copy of the bingo ordinance and will provide that copy to all persons who are in immediate charge of the bingo game or responsible for its conduct. I understand that the proceeds of the bingo games must be used only for a charitable purpose, except that a portion of the proceeds, not exceeding \$500 cash or kind, or both, for each separate game, may be used for prizes, and a portion of the proceeds, not to exceed 20% of the proceeds before the deduction of prizes or \$2,000 per month, whichever is less, may be used for rental of property and overhead, including administrative expenses, bingo equipment, security equipment and security personnel. No person shall receive or pay a profit, wage, or salary from any bingo game.
