













- FAA Written Consent approving manufacturing land use at Marina Municipal Airport Issued
 Wednesday March 1, 2023
- CEQA/NEPA and all entitlements already approved by City of Marina and FAA



Energy Service, Infrastructure & Sourcing

- Completion of 3 mi run for new 10MW service to Marina Airport
 - Total \$4.5M project cost
 - On track for completion late-march/early-April 2023
- PG&E inter-departmental project liaison established
- 100% renewable energy sourcing available through PG&E and 3CE
- Favorable economic development rates
- Critical infrastructure scheduled for timely delivery Spring 2023

- FY 22/23 \$400k grant funded: 24 FTE entry-level apprentices
- FY 23/25 \$600k grant invited extension underway
- FY 23/25 Central Coast CERF grant application submitted

- FY22/23 FY24/25 \$600k Direct employer contract process underway; Additional direct contracts possible
- Multiple Employer Contractor contract via educational and workforce development partners are available to support the upskilling additional California-based workers


